NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS

1. NAME

The name of the Trust shall be HODWINS EDUCATIONAL TRUST

2. REGISTERED OFFICE:

The registered office of the Trust shall be at Simalga, N.H. 27, Near Satalga Main Station, P.O. Satalga, Kamrup - 78104. The Trust shall function in any other place where the Board may decide upon. The jurisdiction of the Trust or any other affairs of the Trust can be carried out at such other places as the Board may decide upon from time to time. The area of operation of the Trust shall be whole of India.

3. OBJECTS:

The principal objects of the Trust shall be-

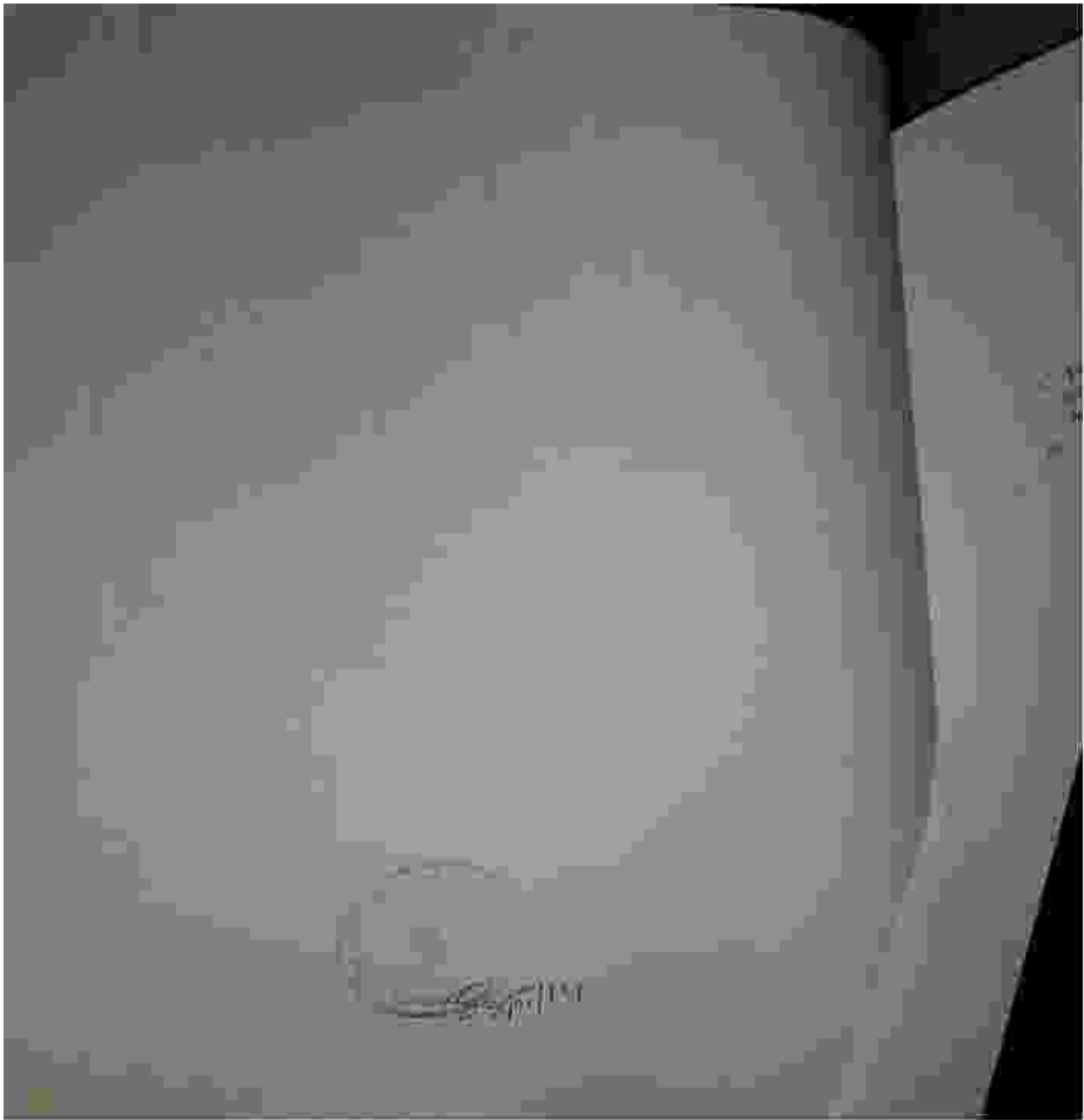
- a. Education, relief of the poor, medical relief and advancement of any other charitable objects of general public utility.
- b. To assist, maintain, establish and promote institutions, centres, schools, colleges, universities etc. for imparting education or training in the domain of primary, secondary, higher secondary, undergraduate, graduate, post graduate course at such places as may be decided by the Trust - only to the extent and in the manner mentioned and according to the bye-laws and rules introduced or introduced by Indian Government, State Government or its officers.

1. The Board of Trustees shall have the power to appoint and remove members as Trustees. The Trustees shall hold office for such period as the Board may determine until they shall be removed in terms of clause (d) below. All the are governed by the Board.

2. No person shall be eligible to be appointed as a Trustee and a Trustee shall cease to hold office if:

1. He/she is adjudged a person of unsound mind.
2. He/she has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude.
3. He/she has been or is subject to insolvency.
4. He/she is or becomes deaf or is suffering from a total infirmity which shall render him unfit for office work.
5. He/she is otherwise disqualified to act as a Trustee according to the provisions of the Indian Trusts Act 1907.
6. He/she commits any breach of trust.

3. The Board shall have the power to remove any Trustee from his position at any time in its own discretion.

6. PROCEEDING OF THE BOARD

a. The Board shall meet as often as necessary to transact the business coming before it and provided that they shall meet at least once in every three calendar months.

b. The Board of Trustees shall provide a quorum meeting in person and if the quorum is not present the Trustees shall be allowed to conduct the meeting.

c. All the eligible members of the total strength of the Board shall form the quorum for the Board meeting.

d. A minute book with pages serially numbered shall be maintained by recording the resolutions passed at the Board Meeting. The Minute Book shall be written up to date within 10 days from the date of meeting or the day of the next Meeting whichever is earlier. The Minutes of each meeting shall be filed and authenticated by the Chairman of the Meeting.

e. Every Trustee present at any Meeting shall sign his name in the book together with purpose.

f. In all matters pertaining to the Trust, the decision of the majority of the Trustees shall be final in case of equality of votes the Chairman shall be entitled to exercise a deciding vote.

g. The Board shall have the power to delegate any of its powers to any of the Trustees to the extent of such delegation as may be required.

7. ASSETS & FUND

The Trustee shall maintain Bank Accounts in the name of the Trust in its own name or in its name and the same shall be operated by the Trustees or by any such person as may be authorized by the Trustees.

8. DONATIONS AND CONTRIBUTIONS

a. The sum of Rs. (Amount) contributed by the donor to the Trust is to be held in the name of the Trust and shall be received by the Trustees as per the receipt.

b. The Trust shall have the power to accept from time to time contributions including donations, investments, fees, grants and aid in money or kind or kind & service or in any other mode either by way of addition to the property of the Trust or in discharge of any debt or in any other manner as may be decided by the Trust or its authorized officers at any time.

V. INVESTMENTS

1. The Trust shall have the power to invest the principal or any part thereof in any manner in which the trustee may deem prudent in the light of the best interests of the beneficiaries of the Trust.
2. The Trust shall have the power to invest the principal or any part thereof in any manner in which the trustee may deem prudent in the light of the best interests of the beneficiaries of the Trust.

VI. POWERS OF THE HEAD OF TRUSTEES

1. The Trust shall have the power to sell, lease, convey, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of any real or personal property owned by the Trust.
2. The Trust shall have the power to execute any instrument necessary to carry out the purposes of the Trust.
3. The Trust shall have the power to sue and be sued, to defend itself, and to compromise, settle, or adjust any claim or liability of the Trust.
4. The Trust shall have the power to do all things which the trustee may deem prudent in the light of the best interests of the beneficiaries of the Trust.

VII. BORROWING POWERS

The Trust shall have the power to borrow money from time to time for the purposes of the Trust and to secure the same by mortgage or other means in the Trust. The Trust shall also have the power to execute any instrument necessary to carry out the purposes of the Trust.

VIII. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT

Proper books of account shall be maintained by the Trust. The books and accounts shall be subject to audit by the beneficiaries of the Trust at any time.

IX. LIABILITIES OF TRUSTEES

1. A trustee who acts in good faith and in the best interests of the beneficiaries of the Trust shall not be liable for any loss or damage to the Trust or its property caused by the trustee's actions or omissions in the course of the trustee's duties.
2. The Trust shall have the power to indemnify and hold harmless any trustee who acts in good faith and in the best interests of the beneficiaries of the Trust.

14. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- a. The Board is hereby authorized to make rules, regulations and by laws for the proper and economical and administration of the fund and other matters in the fund.
- b. The Board is further authorized to make supplementary regulations and to make and alter rules and regulations and provide for such changes as may be required for the proper and economical and administration of the fund.
- c. Any rules, regulations and by laws made by the Board shall be subject to review and approval by the Government of India.

15. EXPENSES OF THE BOARD

It is hereby provided that the Board shall be entitled to receive such salaries, allowances, honoraria, and other benefits as may be determined by the Government of India.

16. AFFILIATION

The Board shall have the power to affiliate any institution or organization to the fund and to withdraw such affiliation at any time.

17. DELEGATION OF POWER

The Board may delegate any of its powers to any officer or officers of the fund.

It is hereby provided that the Board shall have the power to make such rules and regulations as may be necessary for the proper and economical administration of the fund.
